The following is the list of NIPHLE awards categories:

Anyone may submit a nomination except members of the award committee. Any individual in the packaging, materials handling or logistics field may be nominated, whether they are a member of NIPHLE or not. There shall be no time limitation with respect to the contribution made by the individual. Judging is based on the nominee's total contribution to the field rather than to a particular project or period of time. The nomination should be limited to 4 pages of text.

1. Stewart Award: Recognition for many years of dedicated sustained superior service above and beyond the call of duty in numerous highly responsible official capacities for NIPHLE.
2. James A. Russell Memorial Award: Award for many years of achievements and dedicated service to NIPHLE and the packaging, handling, and logistics community.
3. Packaging Achievement Award: For any individual with exceptional achievement in the Packaging field.
4. Handling Achievement Award: For any individual with exceptional achievement in the Handling field.
5. Logistics Achievement Award: For any individual with exceptional achievement in the field of Logistics.
6. Corporate/ Agency of the Year Award: For any Corporate/Agency that has made significant contributions during the year in the areas of Packaging, Handling, and/or Logistics.
